Revamped SIMAP office hours





SIMAP price increase, effective September 1st, 2023

To ensure we can continue to provide a cutting-edge tool and enhanced user support, SIMAP annual license fees will be increased on September 1st, 2023. The prices will increase as follows:

- Tier 1 will increase from \$400/year to \$500/year
- Tier 2 will increase from \$600/year to \$750/year
